

Privacy Statement

PolFIG is committed to protecting your privacy. This Statement of Privacy applies to the PolFIG Web site and governs data collection and usage. By using the PolFIG website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

PolFIG does not collect personal information from you unless you provide it through one of our contact forms or as a registered user of the member's area.

There is information about your computer hardware and software that is automatically collected by PolFIG. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring Web site addresses. This information is used by PolFIG for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the PolFIG Web site.

PolFIG encourages you to review the privacy statements of Web sites you choose to link to from PolFIG so that you can understand how those Web sites collect, use and share your information. PolFIG is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on Web sites outside of the PolFIG and PolFIG family of Web sites.

Use of your Personal Information

PolFIG keeps track of the Web sites and pages our customers visit within PolFIG, in order to determine what PolFIG services are the most popular. This data may be used to deliver customized content within PolFIG to customers whose behaviour indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

PolFIG Web sites will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on PolFIG or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of PolFIG; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of PolFIG, or the public.

Use of Cookies

The PolFIG Web site use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a Web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize PolFIG pages, or register with PolFIG site or services, a cookie helps PolFIG to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same

PolFIG Web site, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the PolFIG features that you customized.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of the PolFIG services or Web sites you visit.
